Place on your Safety Notice Board and discuss at the next Toolbox or Daily Prestart

This is a briefing on the most recent amendment (December 2016) to the Queensland WHS Regulations 2013. It relates to new personal infringement notices and their associated costs / fine to an individual or a company.

Be mindful and remember work health and safety implementation is everyone's responsibility.

s466(3) if asbestos is to be removed immediately a licensed asbestos removalist must give notice to the regulator immediately by phone and in writing within 24 hours	Individual - \$432 Corporation - \$2160	The asbestos removalist must contact the regulator if asbestos is to be removed immediately - check the asbestos management plan
